2011 MARKET GOAT SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

- Health requirements for all Market Goats consigned to the 2011 Sioux Empire Farm Show:
- Health certificates required on ALL animals brought to the Sioux Empire Farm Show.
- Health certificate must contain identification as to breed, sex, ear tag number and owner's name and address.
- Health certificates must be properly made out and issued within 30 days of the opening of the show.
- **ALL OUT OF STATE GOATS NEED A PERMIT NUMBER TO ENTER SOUTH DAKOTA.** Please have your veterinarian call the South Dakota State Veterinarian office for the PERMIT NUMBER at (605) 773-3321.
- Any goat that is not accompanied by a health certificate or does not comply with any of the above regulations will not be admitted to the Sioux Empire Farm Show. Goats must be free of scabies, scrapies and any other symptoms of disease. The health certificate MUST STATE goats are free of signs of SCABIES AND SCRAPIES AND FUNGUS. All goats must have individual SCRAPIES ID tag along with herd ID number.
- Prior to unloading, you must show the health certificates to the livestock attendant. (Health certificates will be collected at check-in.)
- Goats eligible to show are does and castrated males.
- Goats must be under the age of one year and have milk/kid teeth in place. Goats whose teeth have been tampered with will be disqualified at the discretion of the show officials.
- Early entries must be postmarked by Jan. 7, 2011. Online entry fee is \$20 per head; entries submitted by mail are \$22 and late entries must pay \$25. No refunds will be issued.
- Arrival time is any time after 8:30 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 27, 2011.
- Weigh-in of all goats is scheduled from 8-9 a.m. on Friday, Jan. 28, 2011. There is a minimum weight of 50 pounds. Goats will be ear tagged and weighed at this time. Goats will be weighed once with no reweighs. Goats not meeting the minimum requirement will be sifted. All goats will be weighed and divided by weight into classes.
- Goats must be broke to lead and must be shown with collars and leashes and/or halters. No spike chains will be allowed. Muzzles will be allowed.

- No unethical oral or injected altering material will be allowed on any market goat at the Sioux Empire Farm Show. The Farm Show retains the right to sample/test if needed.
- Goats must be uniformly slick shorn with 3/8 inch of hair or less above the knee and hock joints to include the head excluding the tail prior to weigh-in.
- If horned, market goats must have horns rounded off.
- Exhibitors will not be permitted to lift the front legs of goats off the ground during judging. Any exhibitor not abiding by this rule will be disqualified.
- Exhibitors are responsible for keeping stalls clean and will provide their own feed and water. A layer of bedding will be provided with additional bedding available for purchase.
- A \$250 cash award for Champion Market Goat will be awarded and \$150 for the Reserve Champion Market Goat. Sponsored by Iowa Meat Goat Association. The Champion and Reserve Champion will sell at the Mayors' Round-up and Sale of Champions to be held on Friday, Jan. 28, 2011 at the Best Western Ramkota Exhibit Hall in Sioux Falls.
- All Sale of Champions Market Goats will be processed for collection of carcass data.
- Cash awards will be mailed to winners within 30 days of the conclusion of the Sioux Empire Farm Show.
